

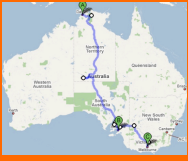

The Project

On the 17th of February 2010, Paraplegics, Andreas Dagelet (from Brisbane) and Dale Elliott (from Adelaide) began riding handcycles from Melbourne to Darwin. Some 5000km. They succeeded! Now Andreas will continue the journey for another 5000km to Perth! A handcycle is a recumbent bike designed to be powered by hand. (Awesome if you can't use your legs)

The Purpose

The journey is to raise funds and awareness for programs to help children born with clubfoot to walk again. We will raise enough to get 1000 children walking. We have raised \$50,000 so far, giving 250 kids the chance to walk. Just \$200 will get a child walking again!

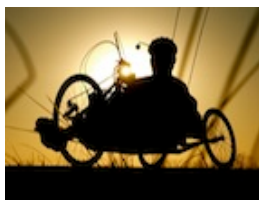
The Schools & Community Groups
