The journey is to raise funds and awareness for programs to help children and young adults with disabilities to lead extraordinary lives. We believe we can raise over \$200,000. This will be achieved through national TV and Radio coverage, visiting and partnering with over 150 schools and numerous community groups.

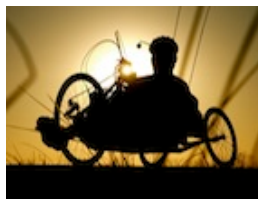
The Schools

What Is Clubfoot?

Club Foot is medical condition where children are born with their feet pointed towards each other and upwards rather than facing out. Without treatment, persons afflicted must painfully learn to walk on the sides of their feet if they survive. Most children with clubfoot in Africa will die because they are of no use to their families. Over 220,000 children in the developing world are born each year with clubfoot.

Treatment is simple including various braces to slowly manipulate the foot, plaster casting or splints. In the Western World, foot manipulations normally begin within 2 weeks of birth. However, for children in Africa treatment isn't always available or affordable. Unfortunately in Africa, clubfoot has a stigma attached to it. Often the mother and child are said to be cursed and can be ousted from their village.

Just \$200 can completely cure a child and with more than 95% of cases treated successfully, the difference in the child's life is paramount. No one will ever know their disability and they will be able lead normal lives. How many can you help?

Fundraising Ideas

These ideas were created with the intention of raising awareness to Clubfoot not only to the children at your school but with the whole community. The more people who know what we are doing, the more children we can all help cure. We have already raised over \$40,000 (200 children). One school in Victoria with just 48 students raised over \$1400 by doing a 1km sponsored walk! Not only do we want your help but we would love to visit your school and talk with the students.

Some Ways You Can Help Us Within Your School

- Free Dress Day – gold coin donations in exchange for mufti.
- Servant For a Day – the senior students are auctioned off and have to 'serve' the highest bidder during break times. At the school's discretion.
- Dare Your Teachers – where students bid on various teachers doing dares. Pay \$2 to see your teacher run around the oval or do 10 pushups etc.
- \$20 participation cards where each kid raises \$20.
- Staff vs Students Soccer Match (Or any sports match)
- Curriculum Inclusive – Track our progress in Geography class. See how many kilometers we have travelled and how far that would be in other countries. For example, the whole journey is approximately 4,902km – which is longer than driving from New York to California in the US (4,465km).
- Sausage Sizzle or Bake Off

Ways You Can Help Us Within Your Community

- Connect us to community groups who may want us to come and speak about our journey and help fundraise
- Connect us to sporting groups who may want us to come and speak about our journey and help fundraise

Fundraising Event Opportunity

In addition to freely visiting your school and engaging your students about our journey we could offer an afternoon workshop or event to deliver specific skills to part of your student body. Leadership, communication, dream building etc.

The workshop could be comedic, motivational or inspirational as Andreas, a professional speaker, coach and trainer makes his living doing so and Dale, also a professional speaker describes himself as a 'motivational comedian'.

In exchange, we would ask that you connect with your community to organise an evening event that would have a cover charge. The cover charge would be to raise money for the children and help with our ongoing expenses. If we set a minimum target of say \$2000+ (We would donate a minimum of 50% of this to the children), any additional revenue could be used by the school in any manner. The event would be entirely controlled by the school and their event partners.

We have successfully done this in the past with schools organising sponsors for the event in addition to a cover charge and other connected fundraising like a dinner or a raffle, an auction or a sausage sizzle, anything fun really...

The evening event could be a stand-up show, a motivational speech or a combination of the two. We would liaise with you regarding content.
